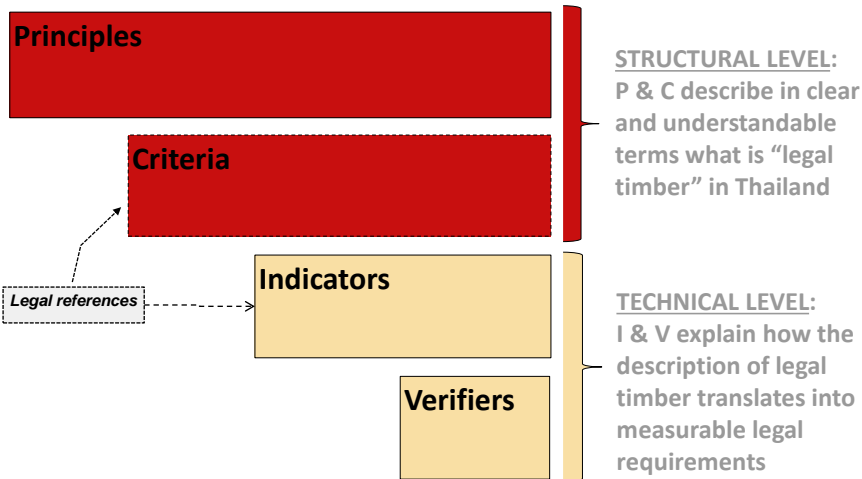

Legality standards	Responsibility
Legality standard 1: Natural production forest	TEG on LL1-3, DOF
Legality standard 2: Concession areas	TEG on LL1-3, DOF
Legality standard 3: Plantation	TEG on plantation, DOF
Legality standard 4: Village forest	TEG on Village forest, DOF
Legality standard 5: Confiscated timber	Department of Forest Inspection
Legality standard 6: Imported timber	TEG on export procedures, MOIC
Legality standard 7: Labour law and regulations	TEG on OSH, MLSWF
Legality standard 8: Wood processing regulations	TEG on private sector
Legality standard 9: Transport, trade, and export regulations	TEG on export procedures, MOIC

Example of Matrix of TLD structure (Principle, criteria, indicator and verifier)

Principle: Topic of the principle	
Criteria: Compliance with laws and regulations on the principle	
Indicator: legal activity/process to be implemented to support the legality of the criteria	Verifier: Evidence/proof of compliance
Objective: what is the objective of the indicator	
Regulatory control: State what is required by the law/regulation	Legal reference: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Article of law, decree, decision, notification.....
