# TEG consultation meeting on improvement of draft TLD of principle, criteria, indicator of production forest (LL1-3)

On 23-24 August 2016, the Forest Technique Standard Division, DOF on behalf of TEG for drafting the TLD on production forest held a meeting at PAFO of Khammouane Province which was chaired by Mr. Bounchanh Xaypaya, DG of PAFO. The representatives of the province, Departments and key stakeholders such as Department of Domestic Trade, DOFI, Pro-FLEGT expert, VFI, LBA, forestry section, POFI, logging unit, POIC, Custom Division, wood processing companies, and village use companies were invited to attend this meeting. The number of participants were 34 staff and of this 4 were women (Detailed list of participants is attached). The objectives of the meeting were to discuss and improve the draft TLD of production forest (LL1-3) which consists of principles, criteria, indicators and verifiers.

After the chairman had given the remarks and opened the meeting, the meeting was proceeded as follows:

- The process of drafting of TLD of production forest, LL1-3 was presented by Mr.
   Phomma Pathoummavong, Acting DG of forestry Technique Standard Division.
- The method and principle of drafting the TLD (EFI) was presented by Mr. Keu Keomuanvong, National FLEGT Advisor.
- Methods of discussion and understanding of draft TLD was presented by Dr. Khamfeua Sivivongs, DDG of forestry Technique Standard Division
- The draft TLD principles, criteria, indicators and verifiers of production forest was presented by Mr. Soukan Inthabnouhack, DGG of Forestry Section, Khammouane province.

After completion of the presentations, there were some discussions. Participants had discussed and exchanged lessons by focusing on improvement of (draft) principles, criteria, indicators and verifiers in harvesting operation and timber movement from LL1-2-3.

The presentations, discussions and improvement of (draft) principles, criteria, indicators and verifiers in harvesting operation and movement of timber from LL1-2-3 are summarized as follows:

- Generally the participants understood and mutually agreed with the draft TLD which was presented.
- It was proposed to include the Decision No. 0141/MAF into the legal references to include the role and responsibility of forestry inspection authority.
- · It was proposed to rearrange the order of some principles to make them clearer.
- It was proposed to consider the social impacts into the principles.
- It was proposed to improve the headings of some principles to be easily understood including improvement of the grammar.
- It was proposed to include month into all legal references.

At the end of the meeting, the Chairman had emphasized and given some directions to the TEG to continue to improve and finalize the TLD particularly to rearrange the order of the principles to be easily understood due to the fact that some titles of headings of principles are still not clear and are not suitable to the real context.

Therefore, the minutes are drafted to be used as reference for the TEG to implement the FLEGT (production forest) in the future.
